The guide to **RED WINES** uses a simple five-point scale. The letters A-E are used in order to differentiate from the red wines. Starting at A, the wines are easy, undemanding and quaffable. At E, the other end of the scale, the wines are more full bodied.

A crisp, fruity white wine with a delightful and ripe aroma.
- 43 **MERLOT MEZZACORONA TRENTINO** (C) £19.95
Scented on the nose, with plenty of black fruit in evidence. Mid bodied and fruity with fairly soft tannins.
- 44 **FRASCATI SUPERIORE** (1) £17.25
A light and refreshing dry white wine with ripe fruit backed by crisp acidity.
- 45 **CHIANTI, L Cecchi Figli** (B) £19.95
Deep ruby in colour, well balanced and a good fruity palate.
- 46 **BAROLO TERRE DEL BAROLO 2001/2002** (E) £32.50
This brick red wine has a complex, woody nose, with a lingering liquorice and fruit on the palate.

Argentina

- 47 **ELEMENTOS CHARDONNAY VIOGNER** (2) £17.00
Zingy and fresh on the palate with a delicate youthful fruitiness on the nose.
- 48 **ELEMENTOS SHIRAZ MALBEC** (C) £17.00
An immediately fruity red wine, vibrant and juicy on the mouth.

South Africa

- 49 **INVENIO PINOTAGE, Western Cape** (C) £18.95
A Savoury dry red with dark fruits and a touch of smoke.
- 50 **INVENIO CHENIN BLANC, Western Cape** (2) £18.95
A dry, juicy white with hints of ripe pear and banana.

- 53 **ERRAZURIZ MERLOT** (C) £19.50
Intense purple in colour with concentrated blackberry fruit flavours on the nose and palate.
- 54 **ERRAZURIZ CABERNET SAUVIGNON** (C) £19.50
Deep ruby in colour with an intense blackcurranty nose and rich, fleshy fruit characters on the palate.

- 55 **McGUIGAN BLACK LABEL SHIRAZ** (C) £21.50
Soft and fruity with plenty of spicy berry character.
- 56 **ROSEMOUNT TRAMINER RIESLING** (5) £18.75
A scented and aromatic white wine that is medium dry in taste.
- 57 **BOOMERANG BAY CHARDONNAY** (2) £17.95
Clean, balanced and crisp with light citrus and apple character.
- 58 **GULARA CABERNET SHIRAZ** (C) £17.00
A juicy, youthful red with plenty of bramble fruit and a hint of pepper.
